## The Water Supply (Water Quality) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2017

### Pressure Filtration Kit DF FP/FDN 800+3 500

Thank you for your recent application to the Drinking Water Inspectorate (England and Wales) for approval of a product or substance for use in the public water supply. This was in respect of **Pressure Filtration Kit DF FP/FDN 800+3 500**.

The Drinking Water Inspectorate (England and Wales) undertakes this testing and assessment on behalf of England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland and your application is deemed to extend to Northern Ireland. As Northern Ireland has separate legislation from that applicable in England, Wales and Scotland, the Department for Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs (the Department) has treated your application under Regulation 33 of the legislation above.

Following the approval of **Pressure Filtration Kit DF FP/FDN 800+3 500**, the Department hereby approves the introduction of that product in Northern Ireland on the same terms and conditions as set out in the approval notified to you by the Drinking Water Inspectorate (England and Wales) in its letter of **21 December 2017**
